## Truckee Regional Aquatic Invasive Species Prevention Program (TRAISPP)

### Inspection Checklist

Check watercraft/trailer for (Circle if found): Mussels, snails, clams, mud, bait/fish, standing water, weeds  
**STOP-DO NOT LAUNCH IF ANY OF THESE ARE FOUND-PROCEED TO DECONTAMINATION STATION FIRST**

**Inspect and check off all items that follow that are part of the watercraft and trailer:**

**Overall hull:** clean and smooth  bumpy or sandpaper feel  other \_\_\_\_\_

**Vessel Exterior:** entire hull and transom  anchors, ropes-(wet?)  bilge, motor well

all equipment attached to hull below water line  through hull fittings  water intakes

**Sailboats:** centerboard/swing keel box  rudder and transom  keel

**Motor:** exterior housings  prop and assembly  prop shaft, fittings, brackets and guards

Ruddes  propulsion system  lower unit  gimbal assembly  water intakes and outlets

**Interior Equipment:** bait and live wells  internal ballast tanks  PFD's  float cushions/belts

Rope and equipment lockers  anchors  waterfowl decoys  nets  waterskis, toys, tow ropes

**Fully Drained:** bilge plug/pump  bait/live wells  ballast tanks  lower unit @ outboard

drain inboard motors/pull plugs  water cooled generators, swamp coolers  activate bilge pump, catch water

**Trailer:** rollers, bunks, pads  license plate/brackets  trailer lighting  wiring  axels

Wheels and tires  springs/suspension  fenders  frame, brackets, pockets and hollows

### Pledge For Healthy Truckee Waters-2010 TRAISPP Pass program

Waterbodies included in the 2010 TRAISPP program are Boca Reservoir, Donner Lake, Martis Creek Reservoir, Prosser Reservoir and Stampede Reservoir. No other waterbodies apply.

#### I Understand:

1. California law prohibits the transport of & possession of quagga and/or zebra mussels and Hydrilla (weed) and that there are severe penalties for these offenses.
2. Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) are spread primarily by trailered watercraft and recreational equipment that stays wet in between an infested waterbody and a non-infested waterbody.
3. The devastating impacts that AIS have on regional economies, ecologies and recreational uses.
4. Trailered watercraft may be banned from Truckee's waters if AIS continue to spread.
5. I have the power to help stop this from happening if I follow a set of important standard practices.

#### Therefore, I Will:

1. Not launch my watercraft in TRAISPP waters after being in a known AIS infested water until after having a Tahoe certified, sealed decontamination performed on my watercraft & trailer.
2. **Clean, Drain & Dry** my watercraft & trailer after each launching.
3. Come **Clean, Drained & Dry** to TRAISPP waters and answer the inspector's questions.
4. Have my drain plug(s) out when I arrive at all boat ramps and TRAISPP waters.
5. Agree to a full inspection and possible decontamination if my watercraft & trailer are not **Clean, Drained & Dry** when I arrive at all TRAISPP boat ramps and waters.
