*Agrostis stolonifera*

*Agrostis stolonifera* (creeping bentgrass): adapted, 2' height, part shade to shade, medium water needs



*Festuca arundinacea* 'Cochise'

*Festuca arundinacea* 'Cochise' ('Cochise' dwarf fescue): adapted, 2'-4' height, sun to shade, medium water needs, quick germination but slow spread, fine leaves with a dark green color, bunch grass



*Festuca arundinacea* 'Quest'

*Festuca arundinacea* 'Quest' ('Quest' dwarf fescue): adapted, 2'-4' height, sun to shade, medium water needs, quick establishment, bunch grass



*Festuca arundinacea* 'Titan'

*Festuca arundinacea* 'Titan' ('Titan' dwarf fescue): adapted, 2'-4' height, sun to shade, medium water needs, quick establishment, bunch grass



*Festuca rubra*

*Festuca rubra* (red fescue): native, 1'-3' height, sun to shade, medium water needs, moderately drought tolerant, rapid growth, short-lived perennial turf grass, minimal traffic, check cultivar for hardiness



*Lolium perenne*

*Lolium perenne* (Perennial ryegrass): adapted, 2'-3' height, sun to shade, medium water needs, rapid growth, high maintenance, short-lived bunch grass



*Poa pratensis* 'Baron'

*Poa pratensis* 'Baron' (Kentucky bluegrass 'Baron'): adapted, 1' height, sun to shade, high water needs, suitable for wet areas

Note: Depending on site specific conditions, cultural practices, and individual seed or plant vigor; plant establishment, needs and care may vary. This is not a complete list.
