Tahoe Resource Conservation District (Tahoe RCD) is looking for community leaders and conservation enthusiasts to fill an open Board of Directors seat starting November 2021. This is a four-year, volunteer term. The five-member Board meets monthly on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday at 10:00 a.m. for approximately 2-3 hours. Additional commitment is required for standing committee meetings that occur on an as needed basis, board members typically participate in at least one committee

The mission of Tahoe RCD is to promote the conservation, stewardship, and education of the Lake Tahoe Region's natural resources by providing leadership and innovative environmental services. Tahoe RCD is one of nearly 3000 Conservation Districts across the country helping people protect land, water, forests, wildlife, and related natural resources. Tahoe RCD has an extremely motivated and passionate staff of approximately 20 full-time year-round staff and 30+ seasonal staff. The main office is located in South Lake Tahoe, California, however Tahoe RCD serves the entire Lake Tahoe Basin.

Candidates must have their primary residence in Lake Tahoe in either Placer County or El Dorado County, including the City of South Lake Tahoe. Candidates with a variety of backgrounds, qualifications, or affiliations and have an interest in serving on an active, conservation focused, fiscally responsible board are encouraged to apply. Directors are appointed by the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors and confirmed by Placer County Board of Supervisors if candidates reside in Placer County.
